

Cultivating Books from Existing Content

- Ongoing teaching and research leads to content creation
 - Course notes, journal articles, industry white papers, conference papers and presentations, tutorials and short courses, dissertations
- Content can be repurposed for book creation
 - Journal articles, conference papers, etc. are length limited books are length "as needed"
 - Articles are like an "elevator-conversation" time limited, but with specific goal
 - Papers (and sections of papers) can become the basis for a book chapters
 - Book content is broader and deeper
 - Books are like an intensive, multi-day short-course
 - Books provide more background, analysis, application, and outlook
 - Substantial introduction/motivation added
 - Examples, applications, case-studies added



Jean Piaget (1896-1980)

Jean Piaget revolutionised thinking on how children learn by suggesting that each child generates their own successive models of reality — a dynamic process punctuated by four stages that culminates in the ability to test ideas and master abstract concepts. Piaget's theories have had a profound and lasting impact on developmental psychology and education.
