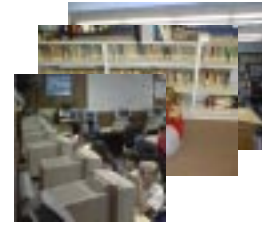

Overview:

Developing computer skills such as programming, document preparation, and electronic communication are as essential to your children's K-12 education as math and science. Our goal is to create a challenging, project-oriented environment in which students can learn to apply their creative skills to a wide range of activities such as science (computer visualization and analysis of real-world data), mathematics (**computer programming**, computer simulations), and technical writing (on-line newsletters, web pages, and other Internet-based resources). Initial projects will most likely focus on web page design and development, and include the establishment of a junior high school **on-line newspaper**. In subsequent years, after the basic infrastructure is established, we plan to develop more of a focus on using computer technology to learn about the **physical sciences**. Basic instruction in the required skills to execute these projects will be given in a self-paced team-oriented environment.
