We have a large percentage of students in ECE 1111 also enrolled in ENGR 2011. This is going to be a bit of a challenge, but we will make it work.

In 2011, we will use Linux and Python, since one of the goals of the course is to reinforce what you have learned in ECE 1111. That means some of you will be playing catch up.

For the moment, there is one small thing I will need you to do.

After you log in, if you are working on ECE 1111, you will need to type the following command:

newgrp ece_1111

Similarly, if you are working on ENGR 2011, you will have to type:

newgrp engr_2011

This will give you the correct set of permissions.

Prior to the start of ENGR 2011, you should also learn how to upload files from MobaXterm. You can usually drag and drop files — it is fairly intuitive:
