Everyone has ece-000 accounts now. You need to log into ece-000 using ssh for a Mac or MobaXterm for Windows, and then type isip_e. This will run emacs in a terminal window.

For Windows, if you want to install a precompiled version of emacs onto your local laptop, you can find a binary for xemacs.

For Mac users, a basic version of emacs is installed already. Open a terminal window and type "emacs".

This gives you several viable options.
