Due to our project being primarily based on Python, a free and open-source software (FOSS), an existing dataset (Temple University Health Digital Pathology), compute server (Neuronix High Performance Cluster), and team of researchers to support us, there isn't a need to purchase anything. We evaluated contributing to the existing compute server via hardware purchases, but after touching base with our advisor, Dr. Picone, he seconded that there is no need to purchase anything and that it would not significantly impact our productivity, or final result.
